Dear families and friends of St Anthony's School,

Parent Pickup

At this month's School Board Meeting we have been discussing the school Parent Pickup routines. We all agreed that we are lucky to have such a well run and efficient procedure in place, keeping end of the school day traffic flowing and managing the safety and wellbeing of our students. Thank you for your patience when congestion occurs.

Lately, we have noticed that some vehicles are arriving very early and lining up for parent pick up, which is causing major congestion on the highway and into our driveway, and also preventing buses from entering. In response, the School Board and School Leadership Team have decided to adjust the timing of our parent pick up routine: **Parent pickup will now begin at 3.00 pm.** This means that if you arrive prior to 3.00 pm, you are asked to park in a designated parking area, or drive around the block (not the turning circle) until 3.00 pm. We ask that there be no queuing in the parent pick up area prior to 3.00 pm. Teachers will bring the students to Parent Pickup ready for 3.00 pm.

We believe that moving parent pickup queuing until 3.00 pm and after, will help traffic move more efficiently through our area. We would also remind you that the teacher on duty stays in the parent pickup area with the students until 3:15 pm, so it is perfectly acceptable to plan to arrive between 3.00 and 3:15 pm.

Please ensure that everyone who uses parent pickup to collect your child knows that they need to arrive after 3.00 pm (or park in a designated space prior to 3.00 pm).




