Mia will go on to represent St Anthony's at the Launceston Brixhibition on the weekend of April 13th and 14th.

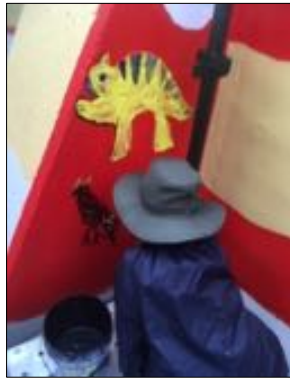
ANZAC Day

Dear Parents,

Parent/Teacher interviews will be held on 9 & 10 Apr 2019 for all grades. Bookings will be opened up on Tuesday 2 Apr at 3:30pm and must be finalised before the 8 Apr at 2pm, when bookings for this event will close. Interviews are an important time to discuss your child's progress with your child's teacher. If you have already done that this term you may not need to book an interview.

Interviews are strictly 10 minutes and spaces are limited. If your child has a Learning Plan, then a double appointment should be booked. If you require more time with a particular teacher, please arrange a separate meeting by telephoning the school on 6327 3618.
