By wearing a school uniform students can readily identify with, and feel pride in their school.

Wearing a uniform is a relatively low cost way for parents to 'dress' their children for school and address issues of equality at the same time.

Summer (terms 1 & 4)

Prep – Grade 6

Boys

Shirt Short sleeved, white with green pinstripe
 Shorts Grey shorts (or grey melange trousers)
 Socks Short grey (*above the ankles, no labels*)
 Jumper V-neck green
 Shoes Black leather (polishable)

Girls

Dress School check summer dress
 Socks Plain, ankle length, lemon socks
 Jumper V-neck green
 Shoes Black leather (polishable)

Hats

A school hat is part of the uniform and is worn in terms 1 and 4. Students are also encouraged to wear their hat on sunny days throughout terms 2 & 3.

Winter (terms 2 & 3)

Prep – Grade 6

Boys

Shirt Long sleeved, white with green pinstripe
 Trousers Grey melange trousers (or grey shorts)
 Socks Short grey (*above the ankles, no labels*)
 Jumper V-neck green
 Shoes Black leather (polishable)
 Tie School tie

Girls

Skirt Green/gold plaid skirt (optional bib to Gr 2)
 Shirt Long sleeve lemon with peter-pan collar
 Stocking Fawn tights or lemon ankle socks
 Jumper V-neck green
 Shoes Black leather (polishable)

Optional/Additional

* Scarves, gloves and beanies in school colours (purple, green, gold) may be worn outside during winter.
 * Bottle green rain jacket/coat may also be worn.

Sports Uniform

Kindergarten – Grade 6

Polo School purple polo top, with gold stripe
 Shorts Bottle green shorts
 Rugby top School purple rugby top, with gold stripe.
 Track pants Bottle green
 Socks White, ankle length, sport socks (*above the ankles, no labels*)
 Shoes Sport shoes. We recommend you purchase runners designed for physical activity to support the foot (not a leisure/fashion shoe).
 Hat The school sun hat is compulsory for terms 1 & 4 and encouraged for terms 2 & 3.

Optional/Additional

* Swim caps are to be worn for swimming carnivals and swim programs. They should be in school colours and are available from the school office or may be purchased elsewhere.
 * House coloured t-shirts, polo tops may be worn for school sports carnivals. These are available from the school clothing pool.

Uniform Expectations

* Students are expected to wear the correct uniform. If a student is not in uniform, a note of explanation is required.
 * Jewellery – for safety reasons no necklaces, rings or bracelets may be worn.
 * Ear rings - one pair of plain sleepers or plain studs may be worn in the ear lobes – not any other part of the face or body.
 * Cosmetics and nail polish are inappropriate for school and are not permitted to be worn.
 * Hair is to be kept neat and tidy. Extreme hair colours and/or styles that may cause undue attention are not permitted. Shoulder length or longer hair must be tied back using plain hair bands/ribbons in school colours (purple, green, gold). Plain head-bands and hair clips in school colours are permitted.
